Poppy Dementia Suite is based at Humphrey Booth Resource Centre, the headquarters of Aspire.

Poppy Dementia Suite has been sympathetically designed to meet the needs of those individuals living with moderate to advanced dementia. The suite of rooms has a modern hotel feel and is appealing to all ages including those living with Young Onset Dementia.



What's available at Poppy Dementia Suite..

All of our bedrooms are fully accessible, each room has an en-suite wet room which is wheel-chair friendly, a carers call system, a profile bed and a smart TV. Two of our bedrooms have a full track ceiling hoist.

We have a tastefully designed accessible bathroom with an Arjo bath to enable a calming, sensory bathing experience. The bathroom has a full ceiling track hoist, toilet and sink and meets all DDA requirements.

Our lounge enables guests to relax, have a chat and like all areas is accessible to all with a call system. There is a kitchen area with kettle, fridge and microwaves, with a smart TV completing the homely and welcoming environment.

The central corridor has a circadian rhythm lighting system designed to replicate the patterns of natural daylight to enhance well-being and to promote restful sleep.

Guests will also have the option of enjoying time in the Poppy Day Centre which is based in Humphrey Booth Resource Centre and has been specially designed as a safe, warm and welcoming space for people living with Dementia.
