Waterside Resource Centre specialises in intensive therapies for individuals aged over 14 with multiple disabilities, who need a complex person-centred package of care.

We offer:

- activity sessions - from performing arts, exercise and life skills, to health and wellbeing and arts and crafts
- a sensory garden and multi-sensory room
- use the Total Communication Approaches and the Royal College of Speech and Language 5 Good Communication Standards
- an open dining area, accessible bathroom facilities, a re-hab kitchen, relaxation room, and physiotherapy space
- quiet spaces and meeting rooms

Our emphasis at Waterside is on supporting the wellbeing of an individual, promoting sensory stimulation, rehabilitation and development of communication skills - to motivate and promote self-esteem and personal growth. The dedicated team of support workers, along with physiotherapists, speech therapists, community nurses and social work teams, endeavour to provide a professional but friendly environment.
